


Tutorial for the CBT portion of the LSPE®


Intro Screen

The intro screen will give basic exam information and includes a button to begin the exam:



Countdown Timer

Once the exam time begins, the countdown timer will be displayed in the upper right corner of the screen:



If you would like to hide the timer, you may do so by clicking on the clock icon. You will then only see the clock icon and not the timer.



Navigator

If you would like to jump to an item anywhere on the exam, you may open the navigator by clicking the three bars in the upper left hand corner of the screen (highlighted below) or the arrow located above the timer.



Once this is selected, a split screen will appear and the navigator will display on the right side (partial screenshot below).



To hide, open or expand the navigator page, use the arrow to the left of the NBEO logo.



You may also navigate through the exam by using the buttons at the bottom of the exam screen.



Flagging an Item

You may use the “Flag this page” button in the upper left corner of the screen if you would like to remember to go back to a particular item. Once you select to flag an item, you will see a small flag icon over the number of the item in the navigator. You may also then choose to unflag that item.



Selecting an Answer

To select an answer, click the corresponding circle to the left of the answer option. Your response will save automatically, but you may change your response as many times as you choose within the allotted examination time. Under each exam item, you will see how many responses you are to select to receive credit.



For a multiple response item, you will see a note under the item similar to the following. In this case, you would need to select all 3 correct answers to get credit for the item.

Taking Notes

If you'd like to take notes for your own reference on any item, click the pencil icon located under the timer in the upper right corner of the screen. This will open a blank notepad window.



Notes will be automatically saved and displayed each time you open your notes. Notes are saved cumulatively throughout your test so you may want to type in the item number that corresponds to each of your notes. Click hide when you are finished entering notes in the notepad. Entries in the notepad will not be sent to the NBEO.

To hide the note screen, use the arrows to the left of the NBEO logo.



Commenting on an Item

You have the option of making a comment on any examination item by selecting the "Send a comment about this question" button located under each test item. Once you type your comment, press submit comment to save it or close comment form if you do not want to save your comment. Comments will be saved for future review by the appropriate NBEO staff and/or subject matter experts.



Drug & Abbreviation List

There are two reference documents available to you throughout the exam. A searchable drug list (DL) and abbreviation list (A) are located in the top right corner of the screen under the countdown clock and notepad icon:



Once you select one of these lists to view, a new window will open:



To expand, minimize, or hide the window, use the arrows in the upper left corner (highlighted in yellow above). You may also choose to zoom in or out using the + or – buttons.
